Answer:	The certificate is valid for ten years.
Reason:	The English version of Official Journal says "The certificate, which should be valid for ten years and be renewable,"  The words "should be" is a translation error that may lead an English-speaking Notified Body to think that 10 years is a recommendation only and some other time limit may also be specified.  The other language versions of PED are clear. In French: L'attestation, d'une durée de validité de dix ans renouvelables, in German: Die Bescheinigung, die für zehn Jahre gültig ist und verlängertwerden kann, In Dutch: De verklaring, die tien jaar geldig is en vernieuwd kanworden, In Swedish: Intyget, vilket gäller under tie år och kanförnyas,
